

# What Is Major League eSports?

## *A quick guide*

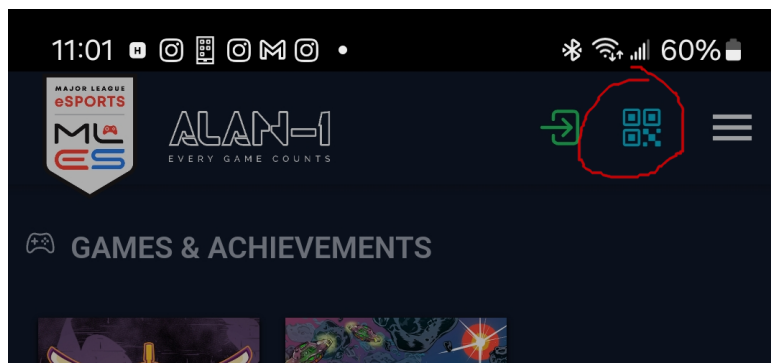
Major League eSports, referred to hereafter as 'MLeS,' is a mobile app and website designed to deepen a player's entertainment experience as they play Alan-1's video games. While many eSports programs restrict who might join, MLeS allows anyone to join. It covers both our console and arcade games. An equivalent application within the industry would be Stern Pinball's Insider Connected. Here is a quick list of features



- Available for free on both iOS & Android devices
- Allows a player to create an account where it will track their scores on both local and national leaderboards.
- Save & track your scores on Alan-1 games. This includes receiving notifications for when your scores have been defeated, incentivizing players to return to the game to play it again.
- Continue from where you left of in a game
- Find a local arcade with any Alan-1 game
- Find local & nationwide tournaments
- Earn game achievements
- Earn league points to participate in the annual Alan-1 nationwide championship

Alan-1 arcade games display a QR code during the attract mode that can be scanned by a phone so that the players can download the app to their phone. Once they create their account, they can then login to the game and begin enjoying a broader experience as outlined above.

After crediting up the game, it will display a QR code for logging in with MLeS. Players open up their app and click on the blue QR code in the upper right corner of the screen to open up the scanner, as shown here:



Scan the code and as long as the game itself is connected to the internet, the login will be successful and the player doesn't have to do anything else.

Each week, Alan-1 sets up a nationwide tournament that is available for players to participate in. This is free and available to all Alan-1 arcade games that are connected to the internet. A tournament portal will appear on the difficulty selection screen, where the player needs to select that (fly their bird

into in, in the case of Avian Knights, or fly their spaceship into it for Asteroids Recharged) to participate.

Operators can also setup their own local tournaments, which will appear on the same difficulty select screen.

Note that all of our Atari Recharged titles will play differently and have unique content from the console versions, making them exclusive. The MLeS app has been made to drive traffic to an operator's arcade and keep players putting coin and time into those machines.
